CAPACITY ANALYSIS

Before downloading anything, identify the needs of your organisation.

Once identified, look for a suitable software that corresponds best to your needs. Also, think long-term! You might be able to use that software again in another project.



NEW POSSIBILITIES

Artificial Intelligence is a very useful resource to gather and analyse data, or simply to ask questions.

AI may pose a threat to your data protection. Consult with your organisation before giving out sensible data. You can always modify the data, so it doesn't include names or other sensible information.



USE SOFTWARE FAMILIES

Google and Microsoft have a wide variety of software. Using the same software will help integrate the data.

Check software compatibility with your own programs before buying.



LESS IS BETTER

DATA IS ABOUT EXPLAINING

Just because you download a lot of software doesn't mean your data will be more comprehensible.
